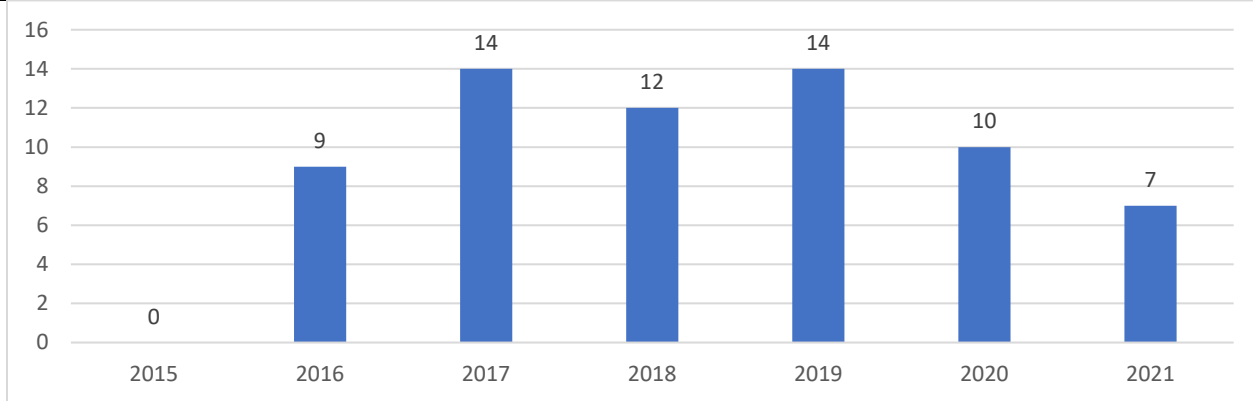


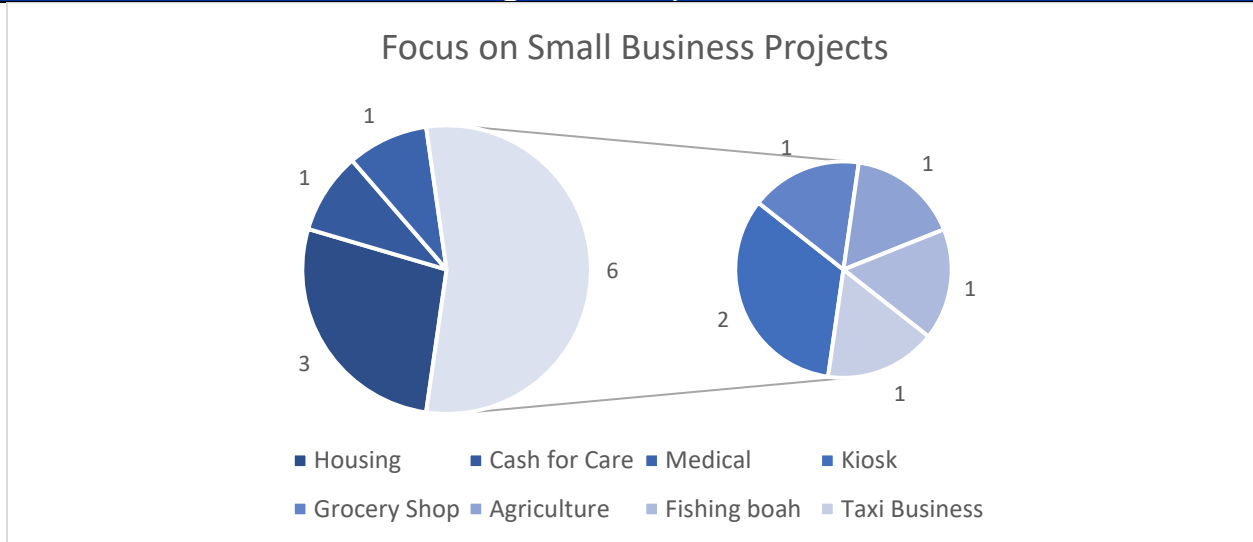
Reintegration Assistance – Flat Funding 2021 – Somalia

- **Implementation support for 7 reintegration projects** in 2021 (for a total of USD 31'590 - **6 male beneficiaries, 1 female beneficiary**, no children)
- **Return operations for 6 cases** (4 men, 2 women), **4 persons** travelled with **escort**
- IOM Somalia was supported through a **Swiss flat funding** of USD 52'965 in 2021
- **Business Training** was conducted for **12 beneficiaries**
- 71% of the beneficiaries returned to **Central Somalia**, while 14% returned to **Hargeisa** and 14% to **Galkayo**.
- Generally, the number of migrants returning to Somalia from Switzerland decreased again in 2021, most probably linked to the difficult socio-economic situation in the country. In 2022, Somalia will no longer belong to the flat-funded countries under the RAS project.

Business Training Results

- While business training activities could not be implemented in 2020 due to the Covid19 pandemic, a total of **12 beneficiaries** (8 men, 4 women) took part in **Business Development Training** in 2021. Unfortunately, none of the returnees from Switzerland were able to join the training in the end. As in Nigeria, IOM used the training module of the International Labour Organization (ILO) named “Start and Improve Your Business (SIYB)”, which was delivered by the training department of the Somali Ministry of Labor and Social Affairs (MOLSA).
- A proposed **Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET)** had to be cancelled as most of the returnees were facing livelihood problems as a result of an increase in food commodities. Struggling with everyday income hindered them from taking a training.
